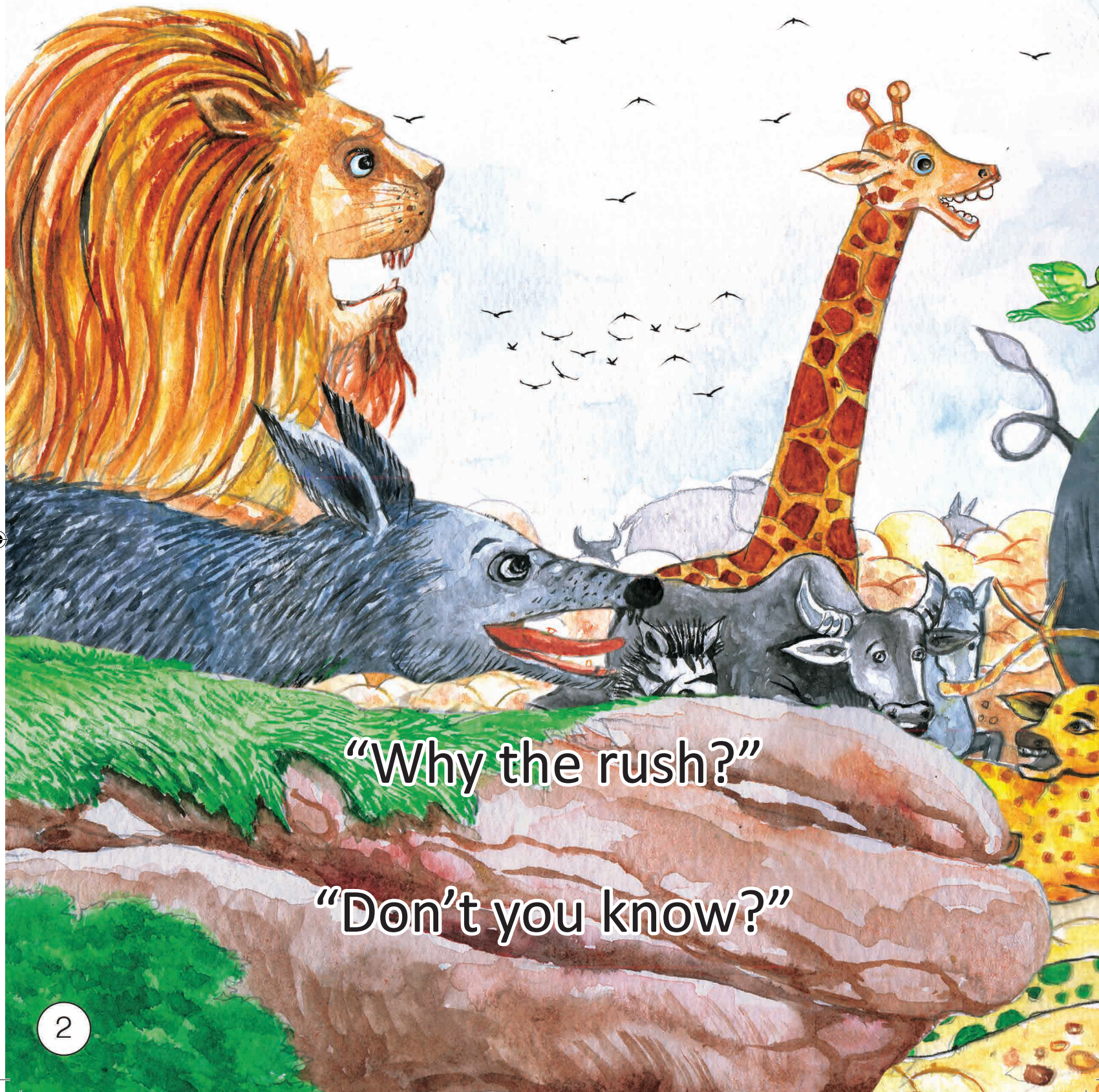

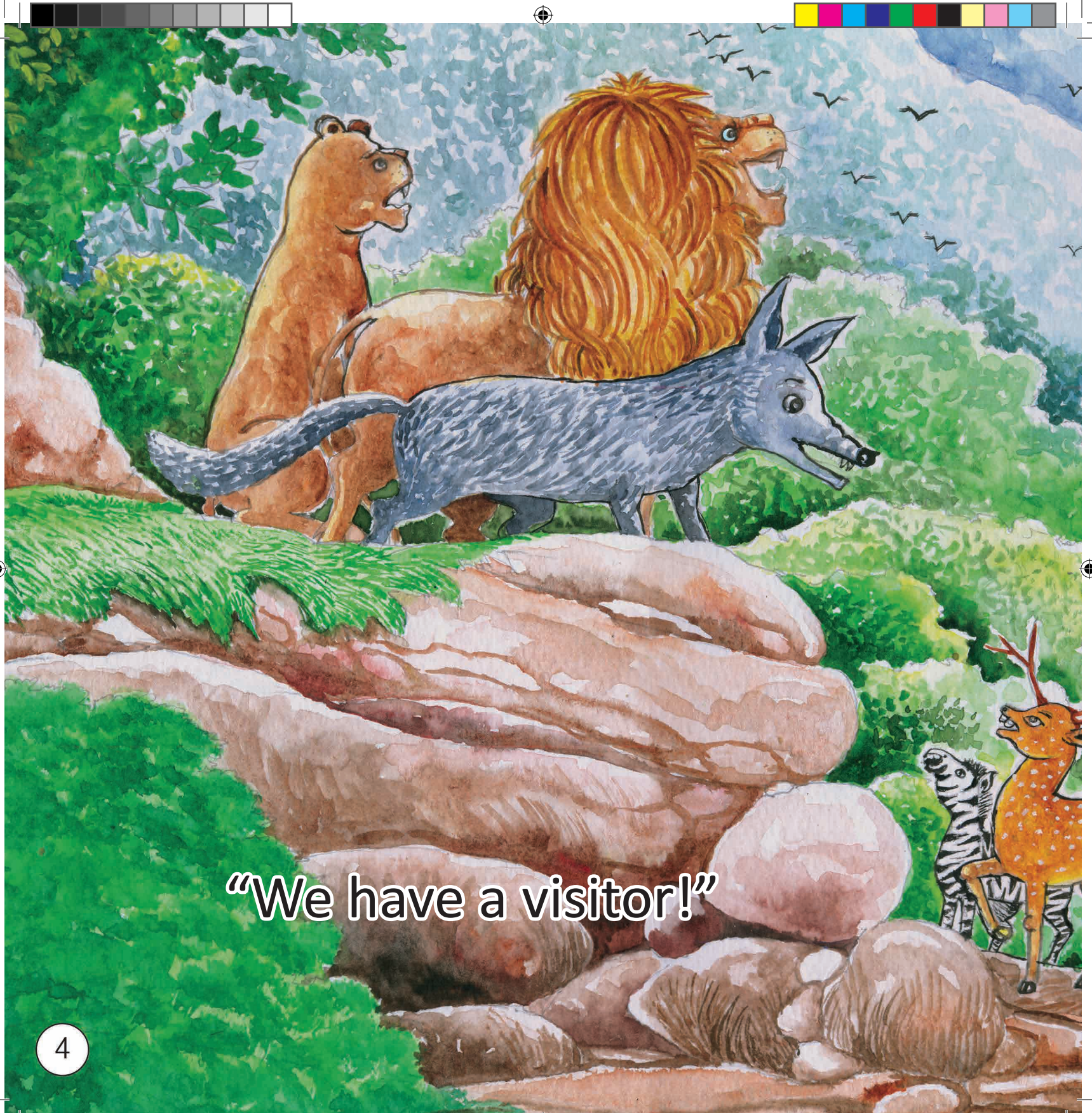
“Why the rush?”

“Don’t you know?”

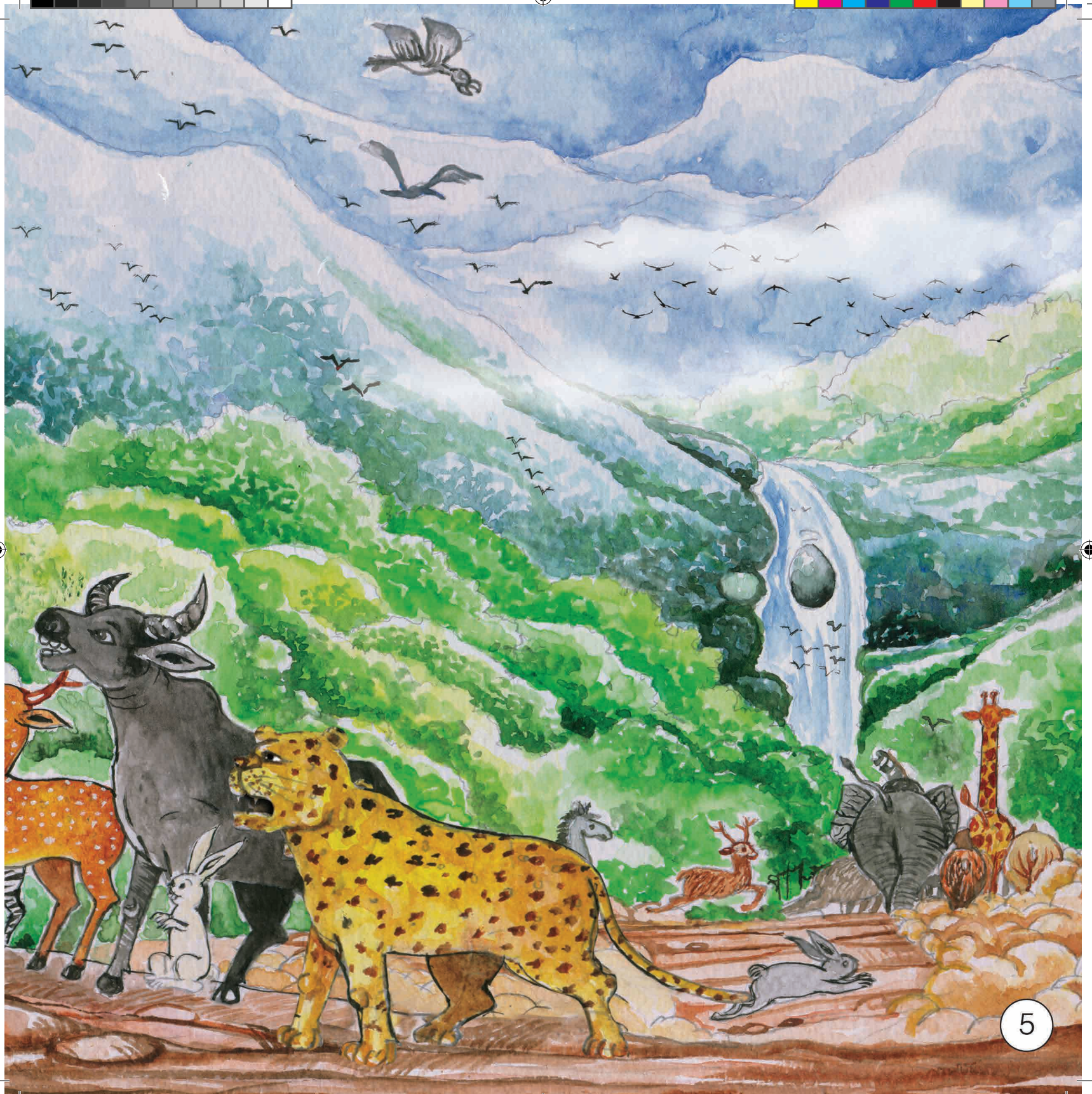


“Didn't the eagle

“Let’s find out who it is first!”




All the animals rush and push
